On April 13, 2007, the AICP Commission approved a measure requiring AICP members to engage in continuing education in order to maintain their certification.

**Between January 1, 2008, and December 31, 2009,
AICP members must earn a total of 32 CM credits
(1 hour = 1 CM credit).**
